Deepwater Masterplan: A plan for the village's future

Deepwater already has so much to love, heritage buildings, a beautiful river, a growing artisan economy, and a community that knows how to care for each other. The Deepwater Masterplan is an opportunity to build on that, by revealing what makes this village special and backing it with a robust plan and investment for its future.

Leading the project is Riarna Sheridan, Director of Place and Growth at Glen Innes Severn Council, working closely with Kylie Long, the project facilitator who will be leading the on the ground engagement activities in Deepwater from 21 July - 12 September. The Masterplan is the first project to be delivered under Council's five-year Draft Precincts Activation

Framework and Strategy - a program built on the understanding that Council and community each bring something essential to the process.

Council officers, leaders and councillors will be involved throughout - joining engagement activities through the village including a workshop scheduled for 12 September, 2-5pm at the Deepwater School of Arts.

Kylie will also become a familiar face in Deepwater over the coming months, visiting community groups, businesses and gathering places to hear what people think. Some of the things the project will be exploring include the arrival experience and how the village presents itself from the highway, the river and its

potential for better facilities and recreation, public spaces designed for connection, heritage assets, footpaths and public facilities, and what Deepwater needs to welcome visitors and encourage them to stay longer.

She'll also be sharing regular updates on the Deepwater Progress Association Facebook page as the project unfolds.

The project team is looking forward to spending time in Deepwater and hearing from as many residents, businesses and community groups as possible. Engagement activities are now open and Kylie is already busy talking with locals.

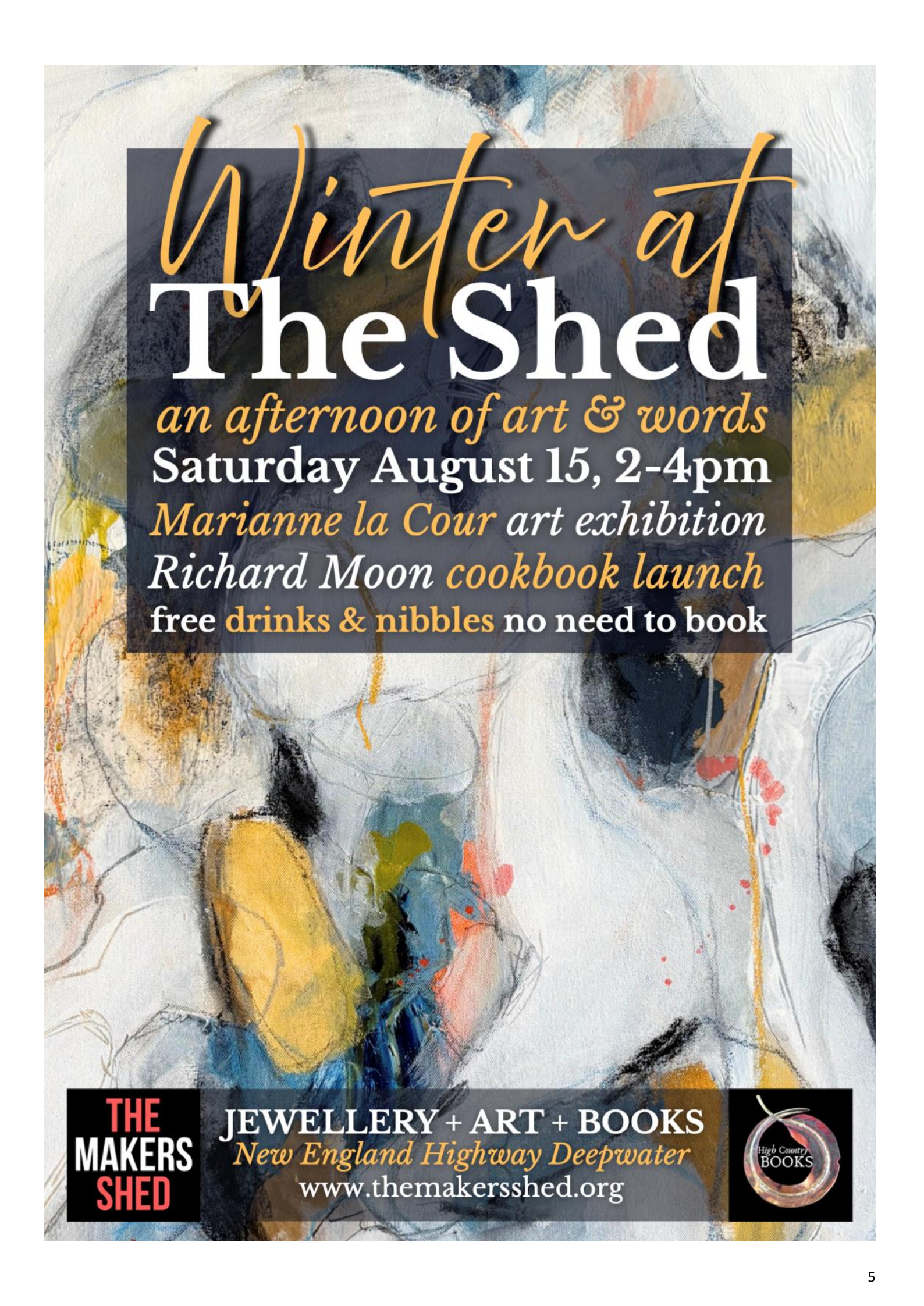

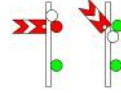
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Deepwater Railway

Station



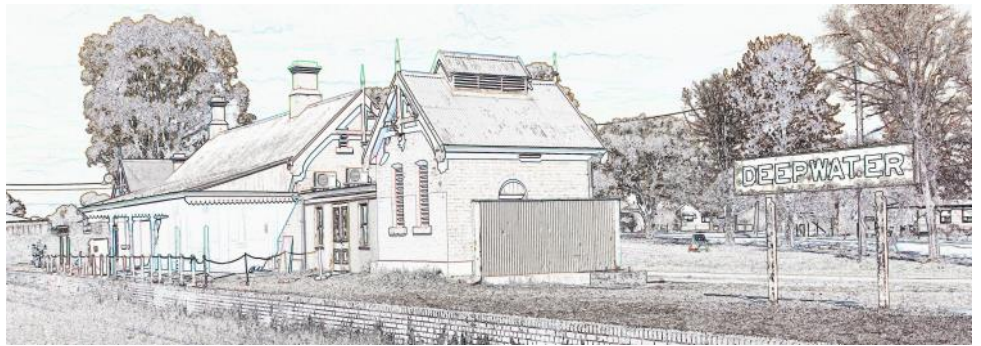
The Railway Station was opened to the public on Monday 20th July from 9am until 3 pm. Three two-hour shifts are divided each Monday and Friday.

A friend of the Railway came out from Glen Innes to do three hours on Tuesday 21st, thanks Glenn.

A committee member came and did 10.30 to 12.30 on the Wednesday and donated a lovely visitors book with pen. Five people signed it on the first day. About thirty signed it on the Friday the 24th that the doors were open from 9 until 3.

Our wonderful Joe (community worker) made the platform bollards – we now need to get a sign stating that access to the rail track is forbidden.

Sadly, on the night of the 23rd at 1.15 am



some vicious person attacked one of the southern doors with an axe. They also destroyed two more doors at the station. Nothing stolen or disturbed just the violent attack on the structure. Police did forensic tests and Council have boarded up the wrecked doors. We (the Progress Association) have plans to get all the rooms ready for an open day for the community on **Saturday 29th August from 3 to 5 with a mulled wine and cheese and music** afternoon. The above will make it a bit harder for the date to be reached – but we are ready to work hard

(contact us if you'd like to help) to make it happen. We are grateful to about 20 of the volunteers from UTS who recently helped get the building ready to open. The Glen Innes Severn Council have been very, very supportive and have replaced all three broken windows which had been boarded up for about 3 years – after the last break into the building. We are liaising with the Heritage Advisor at Council for a way forward with renovations.

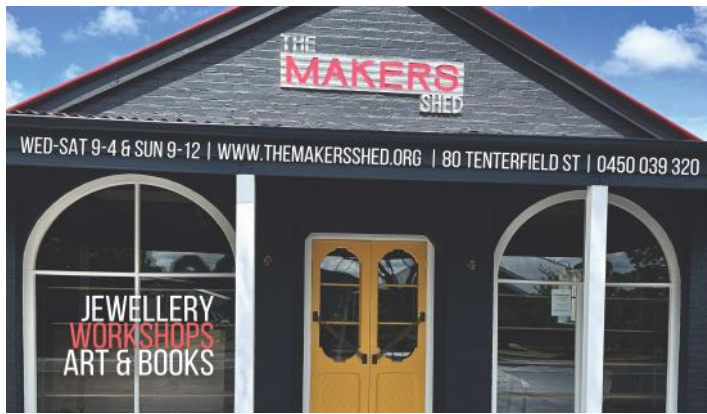
